world application. The platform empowers students to learn, lead, and contribute meaningfully to society while developing future-ready professional skills.

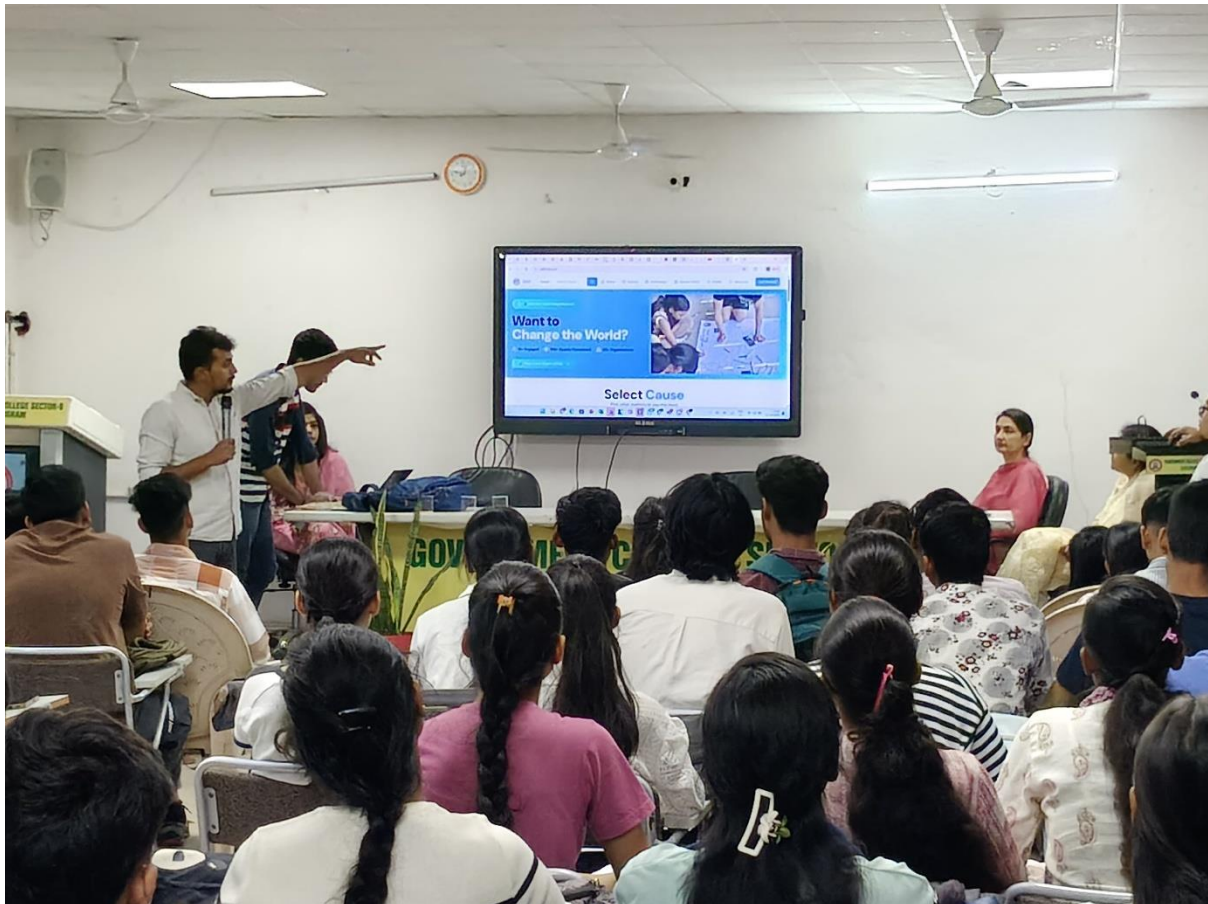
Through its unique structure, VAll offers students access to:

Day 3: Introduction to Tally The third day focused on Tally, a widely used accounting software. Students were introduced to the basics of Tally, including company creation, ledger creation, voucher entry, and an overview of basic accounting concepts. The session helped students understand how Tally is used for maintaining financial records, managing accounts, and generating reports.
